Variety Shiraz

Region Heathcote

Vineyard The fruit was sourced from De Bortoli's own Freemans bridge Vineyard positioned in the ancient red Cambrian soils of the Northern Heathcote region.

Size: 750 ml

Tasting Notes Deep and bright crimson red appearance. An abundance of plum, dark cherry and chocolate. The palate is rich with ripe dark fruits and mocha oak. Full and generous tannins and a lengthy finish.

Winemaker Robert Delgado

Winemaking Fruit is harvested once balance of fruit ripeness, flavour and acid are achieved. Grapes are then destemmed and fermented for 8-9 days in our Potter fermenters, then pressed off skins and each of the batches are assessed and blended to create this harmonious juice Shiraz.
