



## Reh Kendermann is a family-owned wine company and a leading producer of German branded wines.

In 1920 Carl Reh founded a negociant-style wine company in Leiwen on the western side of the Mosel River. Today, Reh Kendermann is one of the most modern wineries in Germany and is a leader in the design and production of brand-name wines and premium private labels. They hold themselves to strict quality controls, and the entire company is certified under HACCP, in addition to BRC Standard “Grade A” and IFS “higher level”. In addition, sustainability is a guiding pillar of their vineyard and farming practices, production and bottling. 87% of the glass used is recycled, 80% of their labels are made from recycled paper using sustainable forestry, and 100% of the wine cases are made from recycled paper. 89.7% of the winery’s electricity comes from renewable sources. Reh Kendermann is certified for organic wine production by Bio Deutschland and the wines from the organic line meet the organic farming specifications of EEG Regulation 2092/91.
