

# TALAMONTI

ABRUZZI, ITALY



The Talamonti vineyard estate was founded in 2001, in the Abruzzi region of Italy by the Di Tonno family. Today it is one of Italy's leading wineries producing estate-bottled sustainable wines of exceptional value. The estate is composed of 80 vineyards located at 985-1150 feet above sea level, with Southeast exposure. The majority of Talamonti vineyards are farmed and managed organically, and the vineyard-estate's energy is 100% sourced by renewable wind power as of 2011.

The Talamonti winery doesn't just talk the talk, they walk the walk. Led by Antonella Di Tonno and her Husband Rodrigo Redmont, they have pursued a commitment to inclusion and diversity. The company ownership is a female majority, and 47% of employees are female. This open and diverse team have created the Talamonti sustainability code where all actions are judged safe, sustainable and authentic. The winery has reduced 29 tons of CO2 per year corresponding to the amount of CO2 absorbed by 1,450 trees. Talamonti is certified for the production and packaging of red, white and rose vegan wines.
