Variety Cabernet Sauvignon

Region Langhorne Creek, Australia

Vineyard Langhorne Creek is one of Australia's best-kept viticulture secrets, having a cool maritime climate than found in South Australia, where winemakers produce some of Australia's most incredible red and white wines. The region is nestled among gum trees on the Bremer and Angas rivers and is less than a one-hour drive from Adelaide.

Size: 750 ml

Tasting Notes Ripe blackberry and blueberry characters, cedar-wood and chocolate. Soft, rick, mouth coating, balanced tannin, hints of classic Cabernet. Full and generous with refined smooth tannins.

Suggested Cuisine A wine that is rich and generous that can be enjoyed with pasta ragu sauce, slow cooked lamb stew or at the end of meal with a cheese Platter.
