The mosaic-like landscape is characterized by small vineyards on the hogbacks that coexist with corners of forest, small woods, hedges and rows of trees.


The Story

UDO Prosecco DOC Brut

Delicate and fresh aromas of green apple, cedar and white peach as well as notes of spring flowers. Crisp and refreshing, the wine is dry but it keeps an amazing finesse.

UDO Prosecco DOC Extra Dry

Delicate hints of apple and white peach, acacia flowers and orange blossoms. On the palate harmonious and sulky mouthfeel.

UDO Prosecco DOCG Extra Dry

It is ample, the nose is filled with aromas of ripe fruits, such as apple and pear, along with delicate floral notes of acacia and hints of white flowers. On the palate hits an ideal balance between freshness and a touch of sweetness. It matches the wide bouquet with a pleasantly sweet aftertaste that lingers gracefully.

UDO Prosecco DOCG Extra Brut

Unripe pear and green apple, wild floral and citrusy notes. On the palate, it is sharp and refreshing, with a pronounced acidity that perfectly balances the wine's delicate fruit flavors.

UDO Prosecco DOCG Brut Nature Sui Lieviti Millesimato

Notes of wildflowers, apple, ripe pear, citrus fruit, croissant, pan brioches. Harmonious and decisive, it reveals mineral notes, sapidity and uncommon elegance.
